Horizon Early Learning Programs are licensed under the provisions of sections 4 and 6 of the Social Care Facilities Licensing Act with Alberta Children's Services.

This allows parents to access the Provincial Child Care Subsidy program, pending qualification, to help pay for their child's pre-k fees.

Guiding Principles

- Children learn through play.
- Preschool years are crucial to a child's learning and development.
- Meaningful learning requires active involvement in challenging and successful experiences.
- Individual needs can be identified and addressed.
- Staff and families work as partners in decision making and accountability.



Objectives

- To provide and model a safe and positive learning environment.
- To encourage each child to practice and learn resourcefulness and spontaneity.
- To immerse children in a language enriched environment.
- To develop a sense of fair play and positive social interaction skills.
- To encourage parent/child learning opportunities.
- To orient children to common routines in a school environment.



Program Registration

- A Child must be 4 years old as of December 31 in the year of entry.
- Children with a diagnosed developmental delay may qualify for early entry to a pre school program.

- Registration forms are available at any Horizon School or on the Horizon School Division website at: www.horizon.ab.ca (under "Jurisdiction Information", then Pre-Kindergarten).

The following must be provided to complete the registration process:

- Birth and/or Adoption Certificate.
- Child's Alberta Health Care Number.
- Canadian Citizenship and/or Landed Immigrant Certificate.
- Student Authorization (Visa).
- \$60 registration fee (will be applied toward program fees).
