

# **Knowledge and Employability Courses**

Informed Consent - Acknowledgement for Parents/ Guardians has been identified by school personnel as an individual who may benefit from access to one or more Knowledge and Employability courses. These courses include: English \_\_\_\_ Social\_\_\_\_ Math\_\_\_ Science\_\_\_\_ Occupational Option\_ Registration in Knowledge and Employability (K&E) courses requires the informed consent of a parent/guardian and the student. Informed consent means that parents/guardians and students are fully aware the Knowledge and Employability courses have reduced academic expectations and greater emphasis on occupational exploration and preparation, and may affect diploma outcomes. Knowledge and Employability courses help students become successful, independent learners and provide the best academic and practical opportunities available for students to reach their maximum potential to become contributing members of society. K & E courses are available to students in Grades 8 through 12 who meet specific criteria. The courses are intended to provide students with opportunities to experience success and become well prepared for employment, further studies, active citizenship and lifelong learning. To indicate your informed consent, please read the following information and check the appropriate boxes: ☐ I understand that my child (I) will be eligible for the Certificate of High School Achievement upon fulfillment of the completion requirements in K&E courses. (Will need 80 credits plus work experience) ☐ If the student is in grade 9, the student can transfer from Knowledge and Employability (-4) to either a -3 or -2 class for grade 10. ☐ If the student is on Knowledge and Employability in grade 10, the student will remain in K & E in that subject, through to the end of grade 12, unless they move to a -2 class at the same grade level in order to achieve a diploma. ☐ This form will need to be signed for grade 9 Knowledge and Employability and signed for Grade 10-12 K & E. If you would like your child off of the K & E program after grade 10, you will need to contact the "Learning Support Teacher" to make the proper arrangements.



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## **Programming Descriptions:**

**Modified programming:** (All grades) Learning outcomes are significantly different from the provincial curriculum and are specifically selected to meet students' education needs. An ISP is required.

#### The student is:

- Not on graded curriculum but receive programming that focuses on life skills, foundational skills and academic readiness skills;
- Assessed in relation to the goals on objectives in the ISP.

May qualify for a Certificate of High School Achievement or a Certificate of School Completion.

**Adapted programming:** (All grades) Retains the learning outcomes of the provincial curriculum. An ISP must reflect the adaptations.

#### The student is:

- On graded curriculum, although often at a grade level different from (above or below) the enrollment grade in one or more subject areas;
- Assessed using curriculum standards.

May qualify for an Alberta High School Diploma, a Certificate of High School Achievement, or a Certificate of School Completion depending on courses taken.

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**Knowledge and Employability (K&E):** (Grades 8-12). Successful completion of K&E courses may qualify students for a Certificate of High School Achievement. Students may transfer to/or take additional courses leading to an Alberta High School Diploma.

Some students may receive regular programming in some subjects, adapted programming in other and modified programming in core subjects.
