



## IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING TRANSPORTATION

As we all work through the challenges associated with COVID-19 we would like to bring your attention to the following matters regarding transportation:

### BUS ROUTE CANCELLATIONS

Due to a driver illness, a current shortage of qualified bus drivers, and the amount of time required to train drivers, it is possible that routes will be cancelled for either a full or half day. When a route cancellation occurs, we will do our best to notify you as soon as possible. The cancellation will be

### MASKS

Masks are required for all students from grades 4 – 12 riding the bus. Students that are not wearing a mask cannot board the bus. Students that remove their masks while in transit may receive a misconduct report. Students that continue to remove masks may be suspended from the bus.

Food cannot be consumed while keeping a mask in place. Students that are required to wear a mask should not consume food while on the bus. Students with a long ride are encouraged to eat and drink prior to boarding the bus.



### SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES / ADDITIONAL RIDERS

Due to required seating plans and social distancing requirements, special circumstances and requests for additional riders, bringing friends home etc. are not allowed.
