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POLICY

THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF HORIZON SCHOOL DIVISION SUPPORTS ALTERNATIVE PROGRAMS AND EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES IN A SYSTEM THAT IS FLEXIBLE AND PROVIDES A VARIETY OF LEARNING PROGRAMS AND MODES OF DELIVERY.

DEFINITION

Alternative program - an education program offered by the board that

- (a) emphasizes a particular language, culture, religion or subject-matter, or
- (b) uses a particular teaching philosophy.

GUIDELINES

- 1. When considering creating or closing an alternative program, the board shall consider:
 - 1.1. level of demand,
 - 1.2. student achievement,
 - 1.3. impact on financial resources, or
 - 1.4. impact on human resources

REGULATIONS

- 1. Alternative programs must comply with the Education Act, provincial regulations, and board policy.
- 2. Alternative program proposals shall be in alignment with Alberta Education's Alternative Programs Handbook.
- 3. The proposal for an alternative program may originate either with parents, community groups or with school division staff.
 - 3.1. The program proposal may be written by parents, the proponent group or the jurisdiction's administrative staff or with the groups working together.

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- 4. Parent and community group proposals shall be submitted to the Superintendent at least one year prior to the anticipated implementation date.
 - 4.1. The superintendent may request additional information prior to proceeding with considering the proposal.
- 5. The Board shall review the proposal and may, by motion, approve the alternative program.
- 6. The Board shall, within sixty days of receiving the request, provide a copy of its decision along with conditions as determined by the Board.
- 7. If a parent enrolls a student in an alternative program, the Board may charge that parent fees for the purpose of defraying non-instructional costs incurred for the program that are in addition to the costs in providing education programs other than the alternative program.
